

# International Trade between Brazil and Zambia

- Trade between Brazil and Zambia reached US\$ 4.1 million in 2020.
- US \$ 3.5 million was relative to Brazil's exports and US \$ 577.8 thousand related to its imports from Zambia.
- There was a 19.8% drop in Brazilian exports to Zambia in 2020, compared to 2019.
- 10 products attend for 85.6% of all Brazilian exports to Zambia in 2020.

- In 2020, Minas Gerais was responsible for 0.3% of a total of US \$ 3.5 million traded between Brazil and Zambia.
- Minas Gerais was the 8th among the Brazilian states that exported to Zambia in 2020.



### Minas Gerais' trade partners in southern Africa



In the last 5 years, exports from Minas Gerais to southern Africa reached US \$ 907.0 million, of which US \$ 1.5 million is related to Zambia.

Zambia ranks 7th among southern african countries with trade ties with Minas Gerias.




# Commercial affairs between Minas Gerais and Zambia

Exports from Minas Gerais to Zambia experienced a 85.7% drop from 2019 to 2020.

Even before the Covid-19 pandemic, a significative reduction in Minas Gerais' exports to Zambia was noted: 80.51% from 2018 to 2019.

In 2016, the most exported product of Minas Gerais to Zambia was electrical components..

Exports from Minas Gerais to Zambia are composed by many different products.

The main products exported in the last 5 years were:

- Other metal furniture (january 2021, 2018, 2017, 2016)
- Upholstered Seats with wooden frame (2020, 2017)
- Other wooden furniture (2020, 2017)
- Frozen pieces of roosters and hens (2019)
- Other cheeses (2019)
